Choose Your Program

Look at Prerequisites

- Basic prerequisites: All programs will have classes that you Must take prior to applying. They
 usually will include the following basic categories. (please reference your specific program from
 above)
 - Biology
 - Math
 - English
 - Psychology
 - Sociology
 - Anatomy & Physiology
 - Some programs require: Microbiology and Chemistry

This is why choosing your program is the first step. You don't want to spend extra time or money completing courses you may not need for entry.

Evaluate your academic course work

- Take a glance at courses/classes you have already taken. You may have met some or all of the prerequisites.
- Just be sure to see if your program of choice has a limit on the number of years since the course was taken.
- Some programs will say "within 10 years" and others "within 5 years"

Complete your required courses

- This goes without saying but I'm thorough so we will list it here anyway.
- o If this is your first-time taking college courses. I applaud you on your journey. I recommend attending a junior/community college. It will not only save you money. And yes, honey we all want to save our coins. But also, the class sizes are smaller. Meaning if you need a little extra help, you won't feel like a tiny fish in a big ocean.
